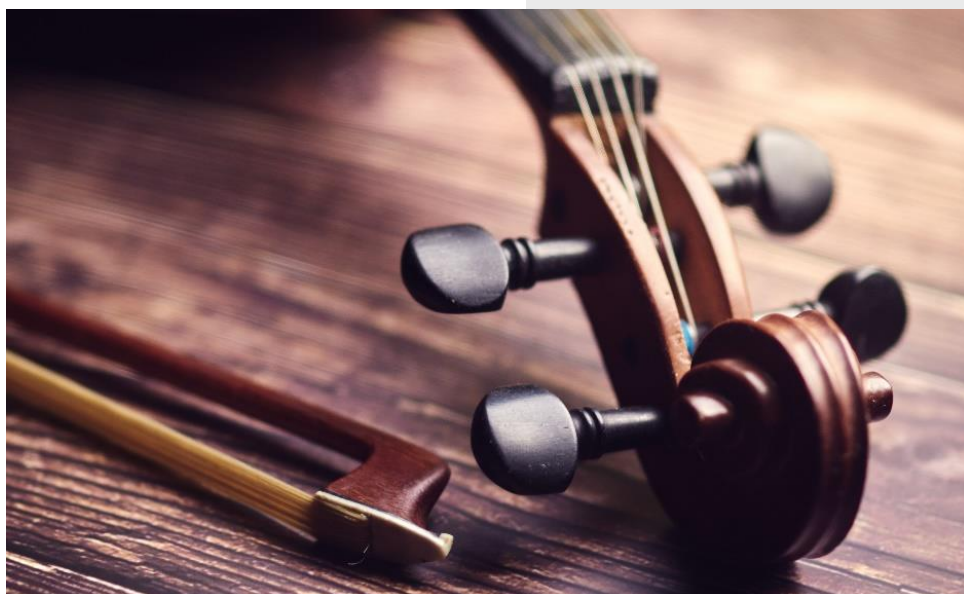


Introduction to Braille music notation
